# **Updates from Mid-Winter Meeting: President Oliver**

The Mid-Winter Meeting was held in February and 4 of our churches in the WNCC were chosen to be part of the Thriving Congregation. They were Elizabeth, Maxwell Chapel, Mt. Pisgah and Poplar Springs. This was part of the Mirroring Project. 90% of our churches in the WNCC participated in the Mirroring Project. The Lily Foundation will give financial support to these churches.

The Bishop met with the General Conference Delegation. As of now, the General Conference will be a hybrid conference, more information is forthcoming from the General Conference Commission. President Oliver stated that delegate, Sis. Jessie Cardwell, will not be able to attend so the 1<sup>st</sup> Alternate, Sis. Emma Devine will move into her spot and Sis. Sonia Barbre will be the 1<sup>st</sup> Alternate.

2nd Episcopal District CDC-\$50,000.00 has been allotted from the CDC. \$10,000.00 will be given to each conference to support churches in the reduction of their budgets. The building will be named The Valerie Faith Gary Bell Building.

## Annual Conference Lay Program: Sis. Jackie Kanipe

The Committee is working on a virtual program for April 30, 2021. The program will begin at 12:45PM and last approximately 45 minutes. Several participants will be doing recordings for the program. President Oliver received word that we need to have everything recorded and to the Bishop's Office by March 22, 2021. The entertainment will be Bro. Robert Wilson (I AM AME), Sis. Harper will sing and Sis. Freeman will recite Still I Rise. We ask that recordings be sent in early. We will ask for our traditional \$50.00 offering through Pay Pal or Givelify. You can also mail your donation to Bro. Winchester. If your offering is sent to Mr. Winchester it will not go to the SEDLO. President Oliver encourage us give online if at all possible.

Information is in your packet on Election of Connectional Officers. Rev. Augustine is running for General Officer (Judicial Council). Sis. Starr Battle, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President of the CLO is running for CLO President. Sis. Starr greeted to the body and gave her theme and platform. "Join and Believe in the Power of Us," no member should feel unheard or unseen in the church of Allen. Sis. Starr asked for the support of her home conference and asked that we visit her website at starrbattle.com. The election will be held on July 11, 2021. Sis. Mary Royster Harris made a motion that the WNCCLO give Sis. Starr a \$300.00 donation for her campaign and it was seconded by Bro. Adam Johnston. Sis. Azzie Conley asked why we could not give her \$500.00. Sis. Azzie asked that the motion be amended and Sis. Mary accepted the amendment to donate \$500.00. Sis. Azzie seconded and the motion carried with no opposers. The check will be mailed on Monday.

Remember that tomorrow the Bishop will ask for a donation for HBCU's. Please be mindful that the AME Church has always supported AME HBCU's. There are numerous AME HBCU's a few are as follows: Abington School of Religion, Allen University, AME University, Bonner-Campbell School of Religion, Morris Brown College, Paul Quinn College, Payne Theological Seminary and Wilberforce. We should be committed to educating our youth and supporting our HBCU's.

What Delegates need to be mindful of when preparing for the upcoming Conventions, General Conference and Connectional Lay Convention Biennial. We will elect Bishops at General Conference and at the Lay Biennial we will elect the CLO President and other vacant offices. Sis. Jackie will send information out at a later date on What to Expect for General Conference and The Lay Biennial. There is no information on cost of CLO Biennial Rooms. We may get information at the April CLO Executive Board Meeting

The Bishop did share with the General Conference Delegation what they will receive (monetary from the SED) for the Delegates and Alternates. Next Saturday there will be a meeting for Delegates, Alternates an Observers for Annual Conference. This will be a virtual orientation.
